PRIMARY & MIDDLE SCHOOL

The teaching process at St. Joseph School helps to garner and harness the varying potential within each student. The aim is to promote and intensify performance and encourage students to be forerunners in all fields. The medium of instruction is English, Students learn a Second language from UKG. They can choose either Hindi or Tamil as their second language till class V.

SPECIAL PROGRAMMES

ADMISSION POLICY

Admission to various classes starts at the beginning of the academic session in March / April every year. Admission tests are held in Feb and Apr followed by an interview.

Age Limits:

Entrance Tests for Classes V to X : For admission to class V & VI the candidate has to appear for a test in English, Hindi, Mathematics, and General Awareness. Apart from above mentioned subjects, candidates seeking admission to class VII-X will be tested in the subject of Science and Social Science also. The syllabus for the same would be of the class deemed to have been cleared by the applicant (CBSE Syllabus)

Fee Structure:

- Tuition fee is payable in two terms.
- The school accepts fee through bank Challan Facility of cash deposit from 1st day to 15th day of every term.

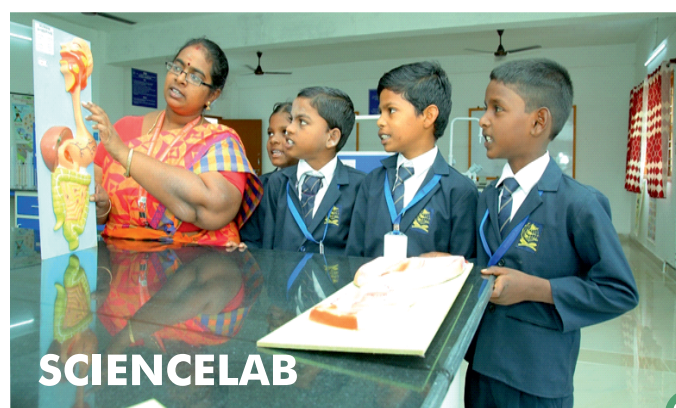


MATHLAB

STEAM & ROBOTICS



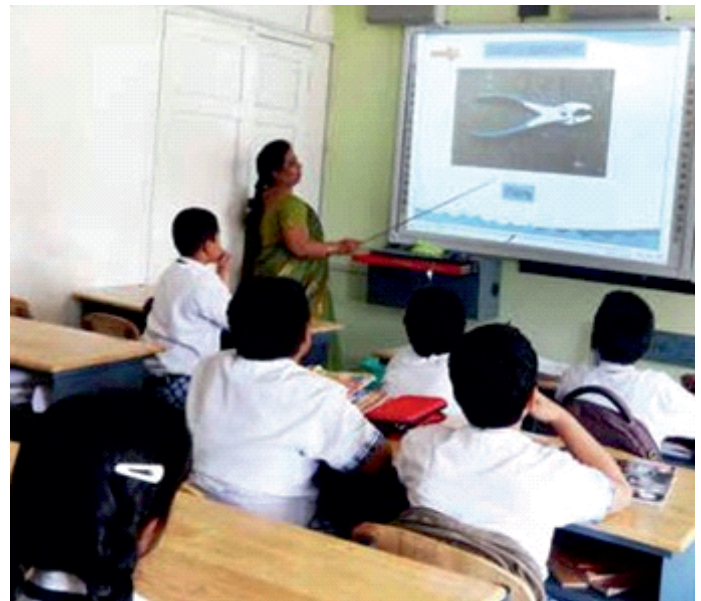

THE THEATRECLUB



Drama and performing arts not only engages with the creative side of the brain, but also provides an ideal balance in students' pattern soft study. It is an avenue to develop cognitive abilities that complement the study of other disciplines and that is why we at St. Joseph have introduced the TTC Theatre Programme as a part of our curriculum. The objective of this Programme is to open up new dimensions of emotional experiences, increase self confidence and ability to think, creatively, imaginatively and divergently so that our young actors, orators and writers are able to think outside the box thereby developing higher order thinking skills.

ASSESSMENT

Effective assessments give students feedback on how well they understand the information and on what they need to improve, while helping teachers to design instruction better. In St. Joseph, Assessment is done intermittently and through three different ways- Formative, Interim, Summative. Our Formative Assessments are short term testing done through very interactive class discussions; a warm-up, closures, exit or feedback slips; on-the-spot performances; quizzes grand conversations, brainstorming, Etc. where our learners are in the process of making meaning of new content and of integrating it into what they already know.

Our learners get immediate feedback which enables them to change their understanding and performance. Our Interim Assessments are more formal and are done, using tools such as projects scored with a rubric, extended essays, written assignments, and Chapter tests. Our students are given the opportunity to re-demonstrate their understanding once the feedback has been digested and acted upon.
